IMPORTANT:

1. Institutions are advised not to wait for the **LAST day** for collection or submission.
2. Institutions should check the dates properly mentioned here or any dates specified separately for any collection or submission of forms.
3. The institutions should start the academic session of class XI within 15 days of declaration of HSLC result.
4. The penalty for failure to submit Forms and fees on the specified dates is a fine of **₹30,000/-**.
5. All General holidays indicated in the State Govt. calendar are to be observed as State/National holidays compulsorily.
6. *The 1st, 3rd and 5th Saturdays of the month are to be utilized for skill development, etc. only.*
7. Schools should also organize activities/programmes related to HIV/AIDS to sensitize the students.
8. *Schools should practice plastic free campus and advocate elimination of single use plastic items. No junk food within the school compound.*
9. Institutions are advised to set aside certain percentage of seats in Class XI for candidates passing out of HSLC Compartmental/ Improvement Examination 2025.
10. All registered institutions should conduct remedial / preparatory classes for Class XI & HSSLC candidates till 15th December every year.

NOTE:

1. School timing: - **Classes A & B – 8:30 AM to 12:30 PM, Classes 1 & 2 – 8:30 AM to 2:00 PM, Classes 3-12 – 8:30 AM to 3 PM.**
2. This calendar is for registered Higher Secondary Schools.
3. **Class XI practical examination, project works should be completed before the first week of March 2025.**
4. **Form No. 45-Class XI result** is to be uploaded in the **portal**.
The uploaded result may be declared on approval by the Board.
5. For submission of Application Forms for HSSLC Examination 2026, refer 'Rules & Regulations for filling up of forms'.
6. Academic report/Question paper observation report: The concerned subject teacher has to write in detail the topic coverage/question paper observation of each subject
7. Failed centre repeaters shall pay a forwarding fee of **₹ 100/-** to the Centre School during submission of forms to be utilized by the centre school.
7. Examination fee per candidate for HSSLC Examination is **₹1500/-**, HSSLC (Compartmental) **₹ 650/-** per subject, Improvement HSSLC **₹ 650/-** per subject.
8. Rate of Higher Secondary School Annual Registration Fee: Government **₹ 5000/-**, Private **₹ 6000/-**
For subjects having practical, the institution/centre shall collect a fee of **₹ 100/- per subject** from the candidates and utilize it for the conduct of the practical.
Institution/Centre should not collect the practical fee from repeaters who have secured pass mark at the last practical examination. The Board shall NOT pay for the expenses to any institution/centre for the conduct of the practical.
9. **No Institution shall collect any fee/money from candidates for issue of admit card/marksheet, etc. Necessary action shall be initiated against any institution/centre practicing this.**
10. Examination fee per candidate for Class XI is **₹ 900/-** for all categories.(Submit **₹ 700/-** to the Board and retain **₹ 200/-** by the School)
11. Registration fee per student for Class-XI is **₹ 400/-** but for migrating student of Classes-XI and XII, it is **₹ 900/-** per student.
