NBE-28/Ad-NSE/2020-21 :: Financial Literacy Course was introduced in secondary level from the academic session 2016 and with reference to Notification No.40/2016 dated 7.12.2016, Financial Literacy Course was made compulsory in Classes IX & X for all the registered schools having Higher Secondary sections from the academic session 2017.

In this regard, a virtual/online training of the Financial Literacy teachers for the newly upgraded higher secondary schools is scheduled to be held tentatively in the **last week of February 2021**. Apart from the newly upgraded schools, **schools who have appointed new teachers for the course** need to be trained to teach the course. Therefore, schools who have appointed new teachers are requested to inform the Board by mail at nbsense@gmail.com on or before **15th February 2021**.

Any other high school interested in introducing the Financial Literacy Course in Class IX for the academic session 2021 can write to the Board at nbsense@gmail.com on or before **15th February 2021** so that the teachers can be trained to teach the course.


