3. Form 16 of Class X, as on 1st March, online submission in the portal.
4. Form no. 6 (a, b & c) to be submitted to the Board through **NBSE Connect app**.
● Submission/additional submission of particulars will not be accepted after due date except for migrating students.
● Last date for receiving of application from schools for migrating students seeking provisional permission for admission to classes VIII, IX & X. **Without prior permission, candidature of migrating students will not be accepted.**

IMPORTANT:

1. All Schools must have email address.
2. Schools should visit the Board's website/portal/whatsapp group regularly for getting important notifications issued by the Board. To install the NBSE Connect app.
3. Schools are advised not to wait for the **LAST day for collection or submission**.
4. Schools should carefully check the dates mentioned here or any dates specified separately for any collection or submission of forms.
5. *The penalty for failure to submit forms and fees on the specified dates is a fine of ` 30,000/-*
6. All General holidays indicated in the State Govt. Calendar are to be observed as State/National holidays compulsorily.
7. *The 1st, 3rd and 5th Saturdays of the month are to be utilized for skill development or bagless days etc.*
8. Schools should also organize activities/programmes related to HIV/AIDs to sensitize the students.
9. *Schools should practice plastic free campus and advocate elimination of single use plastic items. No junk food within the school compound.*
10. *Cleanliness drive in the schools should be carried out on regular basis.*
11. *Inspection/visit of schools will be carried out by the Board's Officials at any time of the academic year.*
12. *In case of any change in the dates specified above, it shall be notified to the schools.*
13. Schools must inform the Board in written (along with relevant documents such as appointment order & educational documents and transfer order) as and when new Headmaster/Headmistress is appointed.
14. All registered school should conduct remedial teaching/preparatory classes for HSLC candidates till 15th December every year.

NOTE :

1. *School timing: - Classes A & B – 8:30 AM to 12:30 PM, Classes 1 & 2 – 8:30 AM to 2:00 PM, Classes 3-12 – 8:30 AM to 3 PM.*
2. *CCE Report Card for Class IX & X students must be properly entered and kept in the school office for inspection/submission as and when asked for.*
3. *Academic report/Question paper observation report: The concerned subject teacher has to write in detail the topic coverage/question paper observation of each subject. The academic report may contain inputs on the content/textbooks or questions in the textbooks. This can be submitted online through the address: nbseform@gmail.com /NBSE Connect app.*
4. *Annual report, Observance reports of Teachers' Day, Environment Day, Children's Day, Constitution Day, World AIDS Day, National Education Day, Swach Bharat, Swachhta Hi Sewa (the Swachhta Hi Sewa is a Pledge of the Nation to create a clean, healthy and new India which begins from 15 Sept. - 2nd Oct. every year) etc. can also be submitted online through the address nbsenag@gmail.com /NBSE Connect app.*
5. *The head of the school can send a responsible teacher duly authorized by him/her for collection and submission of forms or documents. However, for collection of confidential packets, it shall be as per the rules.*
6. *All registered schools are expected to submit the enrolment and particulars of its students to the concerned DEO.*

7. Failed centre repeaters shall pay a forwarding fee of ` 100/- to the Centre School during submission of forms to be utilized by the centre school.
8. The rate of examination fees are: Class IX ` 700/- to be collected from each student (submit ` 500/- to the Board and retain ` 200/- by the school/centre) HSLC ` 1350/-, HSLC (Compartmental)- ` 600/- per subject, Improvement HSLC - ` 600/- per subject.
9. Rate of School Annual Registration Fee: Government -` 4000/- , Private ` 5000/-
10. Class VIII Registration fee and Certificate of Completion of Elementary education is ` 300/- per student for Govt. schools and ` 400/- for private schools, but for migrating student of class VIII, IX & X, it is ` 900/- per student.
11. For submission of Application Forms for HSLC Examination 2027, refer "Rules and Regulations for filling up of Forms" for more details.
12. No Institution shall collect any fee/money from candidates for issue of admit card/ marksheets etc. Necessary action shall be initiated against any institution/centre practicing this.
