NO.NBE-8/Ad- Misc(10)/2026-27: In accordance with the directive received from the School Education Department, Government of Nagaland, all Heads of private schools registered under the Nagaland Board of School Education (NBSE) are hereby informed regarding the ongoing initiative for the generation of APAAR IDs (Automated Permanent Academic Account Registry) for students.

To ensure the successful generation of APAAR IDs, which requires a valid Aadhaar number, schools are requested to:

- **Create Awareness:** Conduct awareness campaigns among students and parents regarding the necessity of Aadhaar enrolment and the mandatory biometric updates.
- **Facilitate Aadhaar Camps:** Extend full cooperation and support for the organization of Aadhaar enrolment and update camps to facilitate the smooth generation of APAAR IDs.

It is important to note that students above 5 years of age are required to undergo Mandatory Biometric Update (MBU) twice: once between the ages of 5–7 years (MBU-1) and again between 15–17 years (MBU-2).

All Heads of Institutions are advised to take the necessary steps to inform their students and parents accordingly to ensure maximum participation and compliance with the "One Nation, One Student ID" initiative.


